Meet the Chancellor



Chancellor Cynthia Larive

Since Chancellor Larive will be our speaker at our January meeting, we thought you might want to know a little about her. Larive is a first-generation college graduate, earning her bachelor's of science from South Dakota State University and her master's from Purdue University, both in chemistry. She earned her Ph.D. in analytical chemistry from UC Riverside while raising daughters Erin and Megan with husband Jim.

Larive worked in the field of bioanalytical chemistry, applying analytical tools such as nuclear magnetic resonance spectroscopy (NMR) and mass spectrometry to the products of chemical separations. Much of her research focused on reducing the amount of sample needed for analysis to develop ways of increasing the sensitivity of measurements to obtain precise chemical and structural information.

She is committed to student success, inclusion, and equity, leading both undergraduate programs and mentoring graduate students, particularly encouraging women and other underrepresented groups in STEM. At UCSC, she prioritized improving graduation rates and eliminating graduation gaps for low-income and first-generation students, and for students

What's Up With Scholarships

Each of the two organizations from which UCSC Community Connections was born, the Affiliates and the Women's Club, had a scholarship program. The Affiliates scholarship funds local students in financial need, and the Women's Club's Rita Olsen Pister scholarship funds re-entry students. Each of these programs is funded by an endowment; that is, gift(s) or bequest(s) that are invested, and the interest income from the investment is used for a purpose set forth in the initial gift.

So because each endowment is already established, as Community Connections we will retain our two endowments for two populations of students.

The Affiliates scholarships are awarded to students in the fall of the year, while the Rita Olsen Pister Scholarships are decided in the spring. We will honor scholarship recipients from both funds at our Spring Scholarship Luncheon in May, 2023.

Larive has authored more than 155 research publications, and has received funding to support her research from non-profit and corporate grant makers.

She is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and the American Chemical Society, and has received campus and national awards for her teaching, research and leadership.
